Joe Palrang and Dan Fahey also rode the sportsman class this past year and had very consistent rides today, Joe in third place with 124 and Dan tied with Maddie Hoover in forth place with 123.

New to the CVOTC and Last place this year was David Patterson with 18 points. He drove from the coast of N.C. hauling his little dog and his Honda Reflex. He had near-crashes all day long, but managed to pull off a couple of cleans. Nick (the squirrel master?) is also new to trials and was second to last with 28 points. Ellis Daw, riding a pretty Beta was third to last. He had his family come out and take pictures of all his crashes. Ellis had 34 points and brags that when he gets his clutch fixed, he will be moving into the expert class. Dwayne's friend Thad had a bad start and did not finish, but we hope to see him at the next event.
