You could play it safe and get 5 to 7 points for your ride, or you could risk it all and get 12 to 15 points if you were successful. But once you put your foot down, you erased all previous points in that section and, of course, a failure....a 5.....gave you a 0 for that section.

This was actually a good format for the first event of the year. Some of us were coming off a long winter with little or no practice, so it enabled each rider to ride at his level of comfort.

The weather turned out perfect...a little cool in the morning with temps warming to around 60 at the end of the day. The traction was also near perfect....the only mud was in the creek sections.

We had 8 sections with 3 loops. That proved enough for just about everyone. There were creeks, hillsides and log sections. Most sections stayed consistent throughout the day.

We had a visit from the land owner, Phil Simpson, who we had not seen in years. Also, it was great to have Bob O'Sullivan back with us competing after his bout with cancer. We had a few new or renewed faces joining us...even one rider from Oklahoma...it was great to see everyone having fun at Lawrenceville.
